CloudFlare unique ID	cfduid	Used to store a unique identifier for your session and apply security settings and improve site performance per user.
Google Analytics	_ga	Used to differentiate users.
Google Analytics	_gat_[id]	Used to control request rate.
Google Analytics	_gid	Used to differentiate users.

All unique ID's are randomly generated and have no public way of linking to users personal data.
